Consistent with State and Local authorities ending emergency orders concerning the Covid-19 pandemic, and pursuant to article IV, section 1 of the state Constitution, Code of Civil Procedure section 128, Government Code section 68070; California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, and the inherent powers of the Court (*In re Reno* (2012) 55 Cal. App. 4th 428, 522),


THEREFORE, THE COURT HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the jury assembly room, individuals may be seated in every seat. This provision is intended to supersede and replace paragraph 2 of Administrative Order 22.18 (September 12, 2022).
2. In courtrooms, individuals in the jury box and the audience may be seated in every seat. This provision is intended to supersede and replace paragraph 3 of Administrative Order 22.18 (September 12, 2022).

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 15, 2023. IT WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL IT IS EXTENDED, AMENDED, OR SUPERSEDED.
