SCREENING AT EAST COUNTY
COURTHOUSE

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 25.06

To protect the safety of all Ventura Superior Court users, the public, and the Court's judicial officers and staff, all Court visitors must consent to security screening to enter the Hall of Justice (HOJ), East County Courthouse (ECCH), and the Juvenile Courthouse (JC). (Ventura County Ordinance no. 5511 (rev. eff. 10/5/04); Administrative Orders dated 8/2/99 (HOJ and ECCH) and 6/24/04 (JC) ("Administrative Orders").) The Court currently conducts court business with the public inside the ECCH on Mondays and Tuesdays (except on holidays), only. As the public does not enter the ECCH on Wednesday through Friday to access court services, the Court does not require entry screening on those days.

The Court has advised the County of Ventura that it will no longer require security screening at the ECCH on days other than Mondays and Tuesdays. The Court's decision is consistent with both Ordinance 5511 and the Court's Administrative Orders, regarding entry screening. Nothing therein requires the Court to utilize or pay for security screening on days in which a courthouse is not open to the public for entry to access court services.
