JUDGE FERDINAND “DINO” INUMERABLE RECEIVES PUBLIC SAFETY AWARD

Ventura Superior Court Judge Ferdinand “Dino” Inumerable has been honored as one of the distinguished recipients of the prestigious Oxnard Knights of Columbus Public Safety Award for 2024. The award ceremony took place during the group’s annual Public Safety Night at the Knights of Columbus Hall, Council 750, in Oxnard.

The Oxnard Knights of Columbus annually recognize and commend approximately thirteen exceptional individuals from law enforcement, the military, fire protection, and the judiciary for their outstanding contributions to our community and nation.

Judge Inumerable was appointed to the bench by Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr., on January 28, 2014, and filled the judicial vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Ellen Gay Conroy in November 2013. Notably, he is the first Filipino American judge appointed in Ventura County.

Prior to his judicial appointment, Judge Inumerable served as a Commissioner with the Ventura County Superior Court beginning in May 2010. His legal career includes roles as a Senior Deputy Public Defender with the Ventura County Public Defender’s Office (2000–2010) and a Deputy Public Defender at the Santa Barbara County Public Defender’s Office (1995–1999). He also practiced law at the Law Offices of Bill Hom (1994 to 1995).

Judge Inumerable holds degrees from the University of Michigan and Thomas Jefferson School of Law in San Diego. Currently, he presides over juvenile delinquency matters at the Juvenile Justice Center courthouse in Oxnard.
